Volunteer Eligibility

- Must be at least five years old.
- Must complete eligible service within a 12-month period (for annual Bronze, Silver, and Gold Awards).
- Service must be unpaid acts of volunteerism benefiting others.

Eligible Service

- Community service projects.
- Civic engagement programs.
- Volunteer service through nonprofit or community organizations.
- Group or individual volunteer activities that create positive impact.

Award Levels

Age Group	Bronze	Silver	Gold
Kids (5-10 years)	26-49 hours	50-74 hours	75+ hours
Teens (11-15)	50-74 hours	75-99 hours	100+ hours
Young Adults (16-25)	100-174 hours	175-249 hours	250+ hours
Adults (26+)	100-249 hours	250-499 hours	500+ hours

Note: Donating funds, political lobbying, religious instruction, worship services, proselytizing, court-ordered service, or serving only family members does not qualify.
